Policy 3-234: Building Access and Surveillance Systems

- Replaced previous Policy 3-234 (Key Policy) in July 2019
 - regulates installation & maintenance of building access systems and area surveillance systems in buildings and outdoor areas owned or controlled by the University of Utah
 - regulates collection, storage, disposal, access, use of surveillance data
- Established Surveillance System Administrators Committee (SSAC)
 - Oversight of all systems, including registration and use of data
