Why Redesign CIS?

- It's old and dated. The current design is from 2003-2004.
- It's difficult to use because it's visually cluttered with many redundant resources.
- It's not “smart.” Users see many links that don't apply to their campus roles.
- It's not responsive to smaller devices (mobile phones, tablets, and small laptops).
- It's not easy to personalize (add tabs/pages, add/remove links, reorder links, etc.).

Project Highlights

- Appointed a dedicated Product Manager in June 2016.
- Refocused on solving primary problems: usability and mobile support.
- Evaluated usability studies on current CIS.
- Enabled analytics in CIS in July 2016. Data is being used to drive designs.
- Evaluated new PeopleSoft software to see if it could solve problems.
- Performed proof of concept work through late 2016 to understand how to design and deliver content in the new framework.
- Engaged business leaders in different campus areas to show prototypes of the new look/feel, address concerns, and solicit people to advise.
- Currently working with UIT Strategic Communication department on a campus-wide communication plan.
- UIT UX-UI and Engineering resources actively, collaboratively creating content in a development sandbox.

Project Timelines

- CIS Portal needs to be upgraded to new PeopleSoft components before other PS systems due to role provisioning and single-signon
- PeopleSoft Finance is scheduled to be upgraded in October 2017 so the ideal time to upgrade CIS Portal is Summer.
- Target for upgrade is June 10.
