



Plastic Flowers!

Using plastic cups and your own creativity, you can create a unique and beautiful project

Length: 10 minutes Difficulty: Medium

Supplies You Will Need

- Clear plastic cups (various sizes and be sure to look for recycling number
 6)
- Sharpies (various colors)
- Green cloth covered wire
- Glue gun
- Scissors
- Baking sheet
- Tinfoil

(Parental Warning: Oven, hot glue gun, and scissor use)

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Use your sharpies to completely color the inside of the cup and the bottom of the cup.
- 3. Cut slits down the sides of the cups using your scissors.
- 4. Place your cups on the foil lined baking sheet.
- 5. Put cups in the oven for 2-5 minutes. Keep a close eye on your cups so they do not melt too much. Also, open up your windows or put on a fan as the melting plastic is smelly.
- 6. Let your flowers cool,
- 7. Use your glue gun to attach the wire to the back of your flowers and/or attach cups to one another to create a layered flower.
