



Reverse Tie-Dye!

Switch up tie-dye by doing it backwards! Grab some bleach and join us!

Length: Prep: 30 Minutes - Total: 1 1/2 Hours **Difficulty:** Hard

Supplies You Will Need

- A Dark or Colored Cotton T-shirt
- 1 Cup of Bleach
- 1 Cup of Water
- Cup
- Rubber Bands

Parental Warnings: Bleach Use

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Change into clothing that you don't mind getting bleach on.
- 2. Take your t-shirt and tie it up with the rubber bands in your preferred design.
- 3. After you have tied it up, dampen the shirt just lightly so the bleach will blend a bit better. This step Is optional.
- 4. Then mix a cup of bleach and a cup of water together.
- 5. Pour this mixture over the shirt as desired.
- 6. Leave for about an hour.
- 7. Tip: If you want it to dry faster, place your shirt in the sun.
- 8. Open It up, If you like the design you can move on to the next step. You can repeat the steps until you have the desired pattern.
- 9. Rinse out the shirt, once you do this, the bleach will not be able to alter the shirt anymore.
- 10. Put your shirt through the washer and dryer and then it is ready to wear!
