



Garden in a Jar

Create a semi-self sustaining garden in a jar!

Length: 10 minutes Difficulty: medium

Materials

- Clear glass jar
- Activated charcoal (optional)
- Gravel or small rocks
- Potting Soil

 1-3 small plants (succulents or ferns are recommended)

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Rinse and dry your glass jar.
- (Optional) Fill the bottom of the jar with a small layer of activated charcoal.
 This will help keep the jar moist and help the plant live longer.
- 3. Add a 1-inch layer of small rocks or gravel for drainage.
- 4. Add a thick layer of potting soil.
- 5. Plant small succulents or ferns in your jar. Plant no more than 1 plant per 1-inch diameter.
- 6. Once you have planted your plants, add a small layer of decorative rocks or moss.
- 7. To care for your garden in a jar, try to keep the jar fairly moist. If the jar is dry (no condensation on the inside glass), spray it lightly with water. Avoid Overwatering.
